

Bright Futures Scholarships – S 86 continued.....

As amended, it would require that students undergo career counseling and the creation of a list of majors that don't lead to jobs. It still ties the scholarship amounts to state budget appropriations and removes language that requires tuition be either 100% or 75% funded depending on what the student qualifies for.

S 86 passed the Appropriations Committee ([Travis Hutson](#) voted YES).
