



The ABCs of Fun Time Early Childhood Academy

Mission: To provide safe, quality, affordable education and care for children of low-income working families and to prepare the children for kindergarten, ready to read and ready to learn!

- 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization serving 96 students from low-income working families in Collier County, Florida
- Opened in 1961 within a small classroom in the Old Carver School under Alma Cambridge
- Moved to a 4,200 sq. ft. trailer in 1970; relocated to the current 8,000 sq. ft. state-of-the-art facility in 2009
- Hours of operation established as 6:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, in 1975 to best meet the needs of working parents (excludes holidays)
- Credentialed and dedicated staff committed to a creative, research-based curriculum designed specifically to meet the needs of 2-5 year olds
- Florida Voluntary Pre-kindergarten provider
- Florida Department of Children & Families Gold Seal certified provider
- Federal Head Start program provider via the Collier County Public Schools
- National Accreditation Commission of Early Care and Education Program accreditation (2012)
- Every child receives a developmental screening 30 days after admission and around their birthdays to detect and address any developmental delays
- Teaching Strategies Gold Assessment Tool and Galileo to measure outcomes in October, January and May to determine progress
- Graduates deemed as performing at and above kindergarten readiness levels by Florida Department of Education since 2006
- USDA Food Program approved healthy menus designed and prepared in a commercial state-of-the-art kitchen and served family style (breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack) to all 96 students
- Early Literacy and Learning Model (ELLM) collaboration co-anchored with Florida Gulf Coast University and the Florida Institute of Education that increases reading instruction one extra hour per day for at-risk children
- Skills-based Instructional Delivery Systems (SEEDS) mentor initiative that works with students to teach and practice formal, Standard English and proper conversational skills
- MusicScores! Pre-K Literacy/Violin Program to enhance learning ability by providing literacy training for pre-school children while developing the skills and reaping the benefits of playing an instrument
- Books for Collier Kids partner to ensure qualified children receive a new book every month to build their home library and literacy skills
- Children’s Literacy & Education PAWS Project (CLEPP) collaboration that brings experienced, trained PAWS therapy dog teams into classrooms to promote literacy, build character and citizenship
- Tuition is based on a sliding fee scale determined by family income and size
 - Average weekly cost to educate a child 2- 5 years of age is \$310 while the average weekly payment for Fun Time’s low-income working families is \$60.
- Funding sources: generous donors, United Way of Collier County, Naples Children Education Foundation, private grants and foundations
- Recipient of Charity Navigator’s coveted 4-star rating
