

The New York School of Ministry

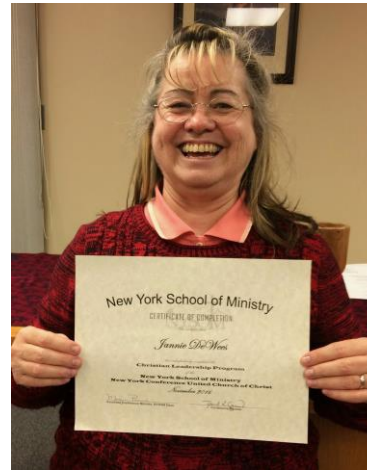
The New York School of Ministry (NYSOM) is designed to deepen the knowledge, skills, and spiritual life of all who participate. We offer a variety of courses, sponsor two 24-hour face-to-face learning events each year, and prepare people for ministry through our certificate programs.

Our courses offer folks a chance to learn about the bible, theology, religious history, pastoral care, and more, with excellent instructors, in a relaxed setting. They are web-conferenced, so participants can connect with others, across the miles, from the comfort of their homes via their computers. We use the zoom platform, which allows participants to see everyone in the virtual classroom and enhances discussion and the building of relationships. Our courses can be taken for a grade or audited. Auditing is a great option for pastors who need continuing education and for folks who love to learn but aren't interested in writing papers or taking tests.

Our fall and spring gatherings bring a diverse group of people together for thought provoking programs and vital community. We come together at a retreat center, gathering for dinner on Friday night and closing with a Saturday afternoon communion service.

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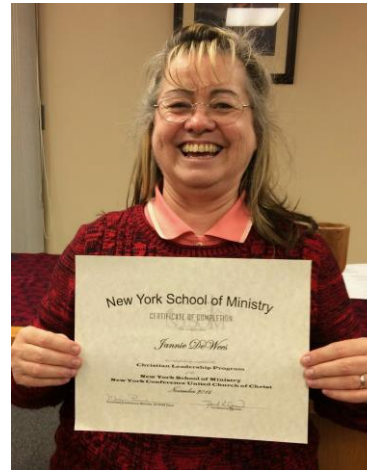
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
