### **Earth Care - Did you know?**

Not all glass/glassware is recyclable. Different types of glass have different compositions. Container glass, as well as glass used in food jars and beverage bottles, share a common melting point, making it easy to recycle together. This is why recycling programs commonly accept only container glass. No matter the content, broken glass should not be placed in recycle bins. Glass bakeware can contaminate the recycled stuff. To dispose of broken glass: wrap in newspaper or cloth, place it in cardboard box, tape shut (write 'broken glass' on the outside) and place it in trash. This protects trash collectors from harm.


