

## Lend Your Voice to Lent

This Lent, our worship series, “Tell Me Something Good,” will feature **short video monologues** spoken from the perspective of people who encountered Jesus—ordinary voices inside the gospel stories.

We’re inviting members and friends of the church to help bring the good news to life.



### Why participate?

These voices help us hear the gospel differently—not as distant stories, but as lived experience. Your voice can help the whole congregation step into the story.

If you’re curious—or even a little nervous but interested—please reach out. Let’s tell the story together this Lent.

### You do *not* need to be an actor

No experience required. No memorizing required. Just a willingness to speak honestly and simply. There are **six short roles**:

- Three written for adult women
- Three that can be voiced by *any gender* (and could even be a teenager)

Each video is about **1–2 minutes**, recorded on your phone.

### What’s involved

- Record the monologue on your phone in **landscape mode**
- Clear audio matters more than perfect video
- Simple clothing and a simple background (inside or outside). Costumes are entirely optional.
- Looking into the camera is better than reading, but perfection is *not* expected
- Videos are due the **Wednesday before** the Sunday they’re used
