Organist Andrew Atkinson is a multi-talented artist and performer from the Gulf Coast. Andrew specializes in improvisation, Romantic music, and sacred arrangements. Mr. Atkinson grew up in a large family (six children) where ministry was prioritized, and music was valued as an important part of daily life. Their father was a Baptist church music director, and their mother was a church pianist who taught each of the children to play the piano at an early age. He began studying piano at the age of 5 and later completed his studies with Dr. Robert Holm at the University of South Alabama.

Mr. Atkinson developed an interest in the organ at a young age and pursued his love of the organ along with his piano studies to fulfill a lifelong dream. Andrew was a gold medalist at the MMTA College piano competition in 2007. He also served as adjudicator for the Alabama Keyboard Festival 2013-2015. Mr. Atkinson was the president of the Mobile Piano Ensemble from 2014-2016 and the 2009 Concerto Soloist. Mr. Atkinson has performed organ and piano recitals, as well as workshops across the country and the world. Most recently he took a concert tour of Accra, Ghana.

Mr. Atkinson is also an accomplished actor and a member of the Screen Actors Guild and the American Guild of Organists.
