## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q: Why is fishing permitted in the bay only?**

**A:** This community friendly flounder tournament is designed for families, weekenders and the serious angler. To provide a fun experience all fish must be caught in the bays of Ocean City and the Ocean City Inlet. The coastal boundary is the imaginary line from the tip of the North Jetty to the tip of the South Jetty within the Ocean City Inlet. The bay boundary is the Rt. 54 bridge at Fenwick to the North, The Verrazano Bridge to the South.

**Q: Do I need to attend the Captain's Meeting?**

**A:** Yes, and bring the whole family for a fun night! Get briefed on the rules of the tournament, sign up for the calcutta, pick up t-shirts, and ask any questions you might have about the event. Then bid on auction items while you enjoy food, drinks and raffles.

**Q: Why is the calcutta for weight only and by boat only?**

**A:** Weight is the easiest measurement to verify using our digital scale and the most common practice for flounder tournaments in this area. By boat makes it more affordable for a team.

**Q: Is there a different registration price for Junior Anglers?**

**A:** No, anglers under 16 are eligible to win the big prizes too, so their registration fee is the same. We do offer a special prize for anglers under 16 for the biggest fish by weight.
