The Belhar Confession of 1986, from which today’s Affirmation of Faith is drawn, is the newest confession in the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) *Book of Confessions*, having been added in 2016. It was written by the Dutch Reformed Mission Church of South Africa, the so-called “coloured” church during the era of *apartheid*, or racial segregation. It is a powerful denial of racial discrimination in the church, and an affirmation of the unity of all Christians.


