



Frequently Asked Questions for Triennium 2019



🔥 Who can participate?

All Presbyterian youth who have completed 9th-12th grade are invited to apply.

🔥 What is the cost to participate?

Approximately \$400 per person (to be shared between church and family).

🔥 Is there financial assistance available?

Financial assistance is available. Please indicate in the appropriate section on your application.

🔥 What happens after I apply?

Your application will be reviewed by the Registrar after January 28th. Once your application has been approved, you will be instructed on how to register for the Triennium.

🔥 How are we getting there?

On the Bus! We will be taking buses from Camp Johnsonburg to Purdue University in Indiana – we will have a fabulous time hanging out, watching the scenery and maybe even sleeping. While we are there, we will not need a vehicle, and when we head out, we will be getting back on buses to return.

🔥 Why are we meeting at Camp Johnsonburg?

Camp Johnsonburg will be hosting team-building activities for youth from our Presbytery and from Presbyteries from all over New Jersey. We will be joining together first to get to know each other better before we head off to Triennium. We will meet at Camp Johnsonburg the morning of July 15th and then take buses from Camp Johnsonburg to the conference at Purdue University.

🔥 What is a Delegation?

A Delegation is a group – you will be going to Triennium as part of your church, your presbytery and your synod. The synod is supporting all of you in attending Triennium by paying transportation costs.

Youth who have more intensive needs for support may bring an adult advisor to support them during the conference, but we will need to work that out with conference organizers in advance.
