"Don't be a stranger!" is something we say to people we like, people we want to see again. Who wants to be a stranger? In a dangerous world, strangers are held in suspicion or, at least, kept at a safe distance. In Ephesians 2, we hear how God changes all that. Christ's love transforms us from strangers into more than just acquaintances, and more, even, than friends. As Christ-followers, we become adopted members of God's family. What implication does that have for how we treat one another?
