# TLC Youth Newsletter 2026

I work in the Youth Department here at Trinity with Tammy Rismiller. I fell in love with youth ministry in 2023 on my first mission trip with the youth to New Orleans. I learned so much about myself, youth, service, and my faith, and I had found my calling.

I started working at the church, and alongside Tammy, I learned even more. Two years into this journey, I decided to go back to school to learn more about children's and youth ministry. I found a program that fit my theology and schedule. In August 2025, I started the one-year certificate program through Youth Ministry Consultants. I began the program in Minneapolis and will return this August to complete my capstone. One of my recent assignments was to create a timeline of everything we want our kids to know, do, and become through each phase of their journey here at Trinity Lutheran. It was a challenging but rewarding task to reflect on these concepts and put them into words.

Tammy and I talked through the concepts, and I created the image you see below. For as long as I can remember, I have been fascinated by trees. Since Tammy often teaches us about being deeply rooted, I enjoyed exploring that imagery and letting it guide my design. So essentially, this is a visual representation of our youth mission statement, capturing the faith journey we hope to walk alongside and guide the youth through here at Trinity Lutheran.
