At times I feel overwhelmed by the chaos of our world and it seems easier to want to hide from it. But Jesus didn't call His followers to hide. He called us to show up. In Matthew 5:39-42, Jesus teaches something radically different from the instinct to hide. He says: "But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to them the other cheek also."

These words aren't about being weak. They're about being courageous in love. When Jesus talks about turning the other cheek, He isn't telling us to let evil win. He's showing us how to confront evil in a way that refuses to become evil in return. Evil wants us to react with rage. Chaos wants us to panic. Hate wants us to hate back. But the Kingdom of God calls us to something higher. We don't stay away from evil—we stand up to it. Not with fists. Not with insults. Not with revenge. But with courageous love. This kind of love doesn't make sense to the world. It's not passive. It's not soft. It's agape—the unconditional, sacrificial love of God.

- * Agape love refuses to dehumanize anyone. We understand that every person is created in the image of God.
- * Agape love chooses peace. Peace isn't the absence of conflict—it's the presence of Christ in the middle of it.
- * Agape love steps into broken places. Not hiding, but entering the world's pain with compassion and courage.
- * Agape love acts by following the words of Jesus. It feeds the hungry, comforts the hurting, clothes the poor, loves the foreigner, invites the lonely outsider, and speaks up for the vulnerable.

We are called to be the Light of the World in a time when darkness feels loud. BUT, God's love is louder. Our courage to share God's Agape love is a spark that ignites healing in our community and in our world. Jesus didn't ask us to avoid the world's chaos. He asked us to enter it confidently and boldly with AGAPE LOVE. And that love—true agape love—changes the World.
