



Genetic Counselor

Ferre Genetics is seeking a part time genetic counselor to join a team of highly motivated genetic counselors working and collaborating in a non-profit setting in upstate New York. This position offers a unique opportunity to work from home, 10 hours a week with paid time off, with the potential to increase to 20 hours per week. Patient appointments will all be conducted remotely via telegenetics video conferencing. Responsibilities include medical record review, obtaining and documenting family history, providing pretest counseling, identifying and coordinating genetic tests as indicated, reviewing and disclosing test results, offering support and resources to patients and their families, and assisting with ongoing care.

Patients seen in our clinics are predominantly adults with cancer, family history of cancers, cardiac conditions, and adult-onset conditions.
