Keynote Address

Finding God Among the Homeless

ALWAYS DRAWN TO THE POOR AND MARGINALIZED, FR. TIM BECAME INVOLVED WITH THE DETROIT PEACE COMMUNITY AND THE CATHOLIC WORKER MOVEMENT AS A YOUNG MAN. In addition to serving as the director of a refugee settlement project, Fr. McCabe also helped repair houses for Detroit's inner-city poor and served meals in a soup kitchen.

On a humanitarian aid mission to El Salvador, he first met the Jesuits, whose faith in action helped propel his decision to attend the University of Detroit Mercy, where he earned a bachelor's degree in political science. He joined the Jesuit Volunteer Corps, serving as its executive director for 12 years.

Fr. Tim answered God's call to join the Jesuit community in 2005, and as a novice provided hospice support to homeless individuals in San Francisco.

After graduating from University of Chicago at Loyola with a degree in advanced philosophy studies, Fr. Tim served as development director at Loyola High School in Detroit, then returned to Chicago to work with the Ignatian Spirituality Project.

Fr. Tim earned a Master of Divinity degree at the Jesuit School of Theology of Santa Clara University in Berkley, CA, while serving as a deacon at St. Agnes Catholic Church in San Francisco.

He joined the staff at Pope Francis Center in 2015 and was named President and CEO in September 2023.
