Invite an international youth into your home for three weeks and share an American experience. Expand your family's cultural understanding, learn about new foods and customs, and possibly a new language all while sharing your own. Your children will build lifelong friendships and will gain new perspectives on their own country too! Gain a global perspective in the comfort of YOUR home!

Open your home to an exchange student and open your lives to the world!



HOSTING PERIOD: 3.5 weeks from July 24 to August 18, 2021

- You can host a youth aged 12-14 or an adult chaperone
- Youth have a range of English language abilities, so host families should be prepared to communicate imaginatively

HOST FAMILY REQUIREMENTS

- You must have a child of the same gender who is within 4 years of the hosted youth (children aged 9+ are eligible to host)
- Families without children of the appropriate age may host an adult chaperone for a portion of the time or the entire 3.5 weeks
- No special activities need to be planned since these youth want to experience American culture, make new friends, and improve their English by staying with your family; only requirement is a bed and three meals a day – they want to be a part of YOUR FAMILY!
- This is a voluntary program; no stipend will be provided
- **Special Health & Safety document is available for review.**
