- Approve MCC policy priorities and other significant policy positions
- Provide direction through development and implementation of MCC's strategic plans
- Assist in membership recruitment and development

Ideal Candidates:

- Ideal candidates are professionals with an interest and/or responsibility for broader, industry-level priorities. This may include manufacturing or EHS leaders, business leaders, or government/external affairs staff.
- The most important qualifications are an appreciation of how trade associations can cooperatively advance industry priorities, and the availability to participate on a working board.
