Update from the Stewardship and Finance Committee

The good news is that we are nearing successful completion of our fundraising for the repaving of our parking lot, having raised more than \$70,500. We thank all those who have contributed so generously. The less good news is that pledged and non-pledged donations to our normal Adult Offering to pay for the day-to-day operations of Northmont have been lagging each month since March 2025. As of June 30, actual Adult Offering contributions total \$180,500, which is \$8,300 or 4.4% below the Adult Offering budget of \$188,800. Contributions during July and August are typically below budget, because many members are in summer vacation mode. Please help us pay our bills by keeping up your contributions during the summer. Thank you!

Northmont, through its Mission Committee has supported PRISM for many years. PRISM (Pittsburgh Regional International Student Ministries), located in BellefieldPresbyterian Church in Oakland, uses the opportunity of students coming to Pittsburgh from around the world to conductinternational ministry right here at home! PRISM offers evangelical hosting, pastoral counseling, and intercultural education experiences to international students and visiting scholars studying at universities in the Pittsburgh area.

PRISM conducts an annual "Garage Giveaway" (https://prismpgh.org/donor/), accepting donations of used goodsthat are still in good, fully functional condition and making them available at no cost to each year's crop of new students. They'relooking for:

GREAT NEWS!! The Anonymous Donor Challenge has been met! An additional \$11,320 has been donated since the beginning of June when the extremely generous anonymous offerwas made to match the next \$10K to be contributed with an additional \$10K donation. A total of \$76,427 has now been received, which, with the additional matching donation, will put us at \$86,427, or 91% of our initial goal!
