3. Youth activities such as "Trunk or Treat" and once a month outdoor events to keep families and youth connected.
4. Children's ministry and time for parents offered on Zoom with links in E-disciple.
5. Food ministry outreach to the greater Albuquerque area with: Community of Hope, Casa Esperanza, Breaking Bread, Zuni Elementary School, and HopeWorks.
6. Outdoor worship experiences: Mountain Cathedrals, Spiritual Discovery Trips, and drive-in Communion services. Stay tuned for more information through the E-disciple and newsletter!
