

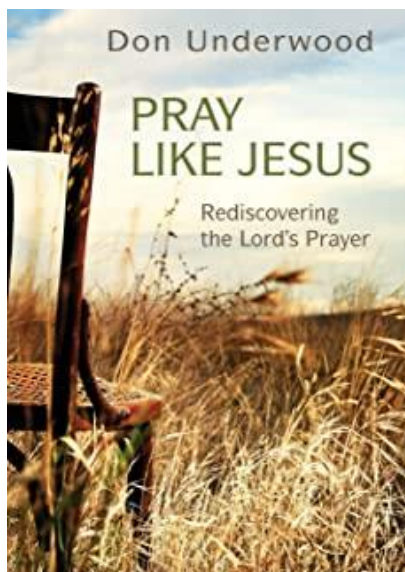


Mark your Calendar – 6 Weeks - Starts April 12, 2021

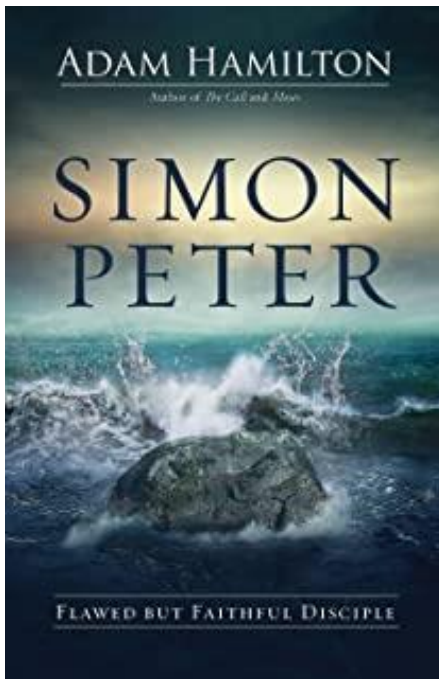
Gardening with a Bible and a Trowel
