We invite you to a “come and see” breakfast at our Motherhouse on Thursday, November 9, 2017 at 8 a.m. We are located at 150 French Road (directions: from East Avenue, turn right on French Road before Pittsford. From Monroe Avenue, turn left on French Road right after Pittsford Plaza).

Our Motherhouse has private space for personal quiet, reading, and writing and space for groups to meet and retreat. We can host 70 people (fewer with tables) and our beautiful chapel holds approximately 150. Meals, a library of theological and spiritual resources, and grounds for walking are available.

We have various programs for spirituality and spiritual development and sisters available in a variety of locations for spiritual direction. We will also share our program called *Fresh Wind in our Sails* which provides a variety of programs, our monthly *Prayer for Our Times*, and welcome you to present a program.
