"We've really tuned in to what our customers like, and what's important to them," Cooper said.

"We are committed to doing everything as locally as we can, so we use Maine cheeses and potatoes, and locally grown greens, and we roast our own tomatoes."

Brunch is served all day, all week now, not just on weekends, with Biscuit Benedict, the Sea Biscuit featuring pan-seared salmon, French toast and custom omelets topping the menu, along with locally roasted coffee, fresh orange juice, and even mimosas.
