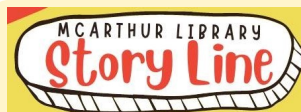

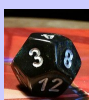

Meals are provided by the USDA & the Biddeford School Nutrition Program and are free for all youth, regardless of income. Please join us!



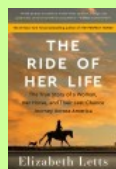

We are excited to welcome USA Today bestselling author Karen Odden to the library! All five of her books are set in 1870s London, and *A Lady in the Smoke*, *A Dangerous Duet*, and *A Trace of Deceit* have won awards for historical fiction and mystery. Her most recent novel, *Down a Dark River*, introduces Michael Corravan, a former thief and bare-knuckles boxer who becomes an inspector at Scotland Yard, and is available in hardback, e-book and audiobook; the sequel, *Under a Veiled Moon*, will be released in October 2022.
