FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES



SMART COMMUNITIES

This economic development assistance tool was created by ElectriCities to help participants attract and retain commercial and industrial customers. NCEMPA and NCMPA1 participants are eligible to receive a \$5,000 matching grant to be used toward specific economic development projects. Smart Communities Grants are matching funds and must involve local funding. Eligible projects include, but are not limited to: site plan development, brownfield remediation, LEED-rated buildings, building/parcel layouts, site certification, rail studies, downtown redevelopment, signage, grant writing, facade upgrades and business retention.



CUSTOMIZED CITY PROJECTS

Economic development starts with member development. Your growth and success is what gives us a charge. ElectriCities will complete customized city projects for six Power Agency members each year.

These projects are required to have a utility and/or city-wide long-term impact. The amount you receive depends on the number of customers your community serves:

- Less than 5,000 customers = **\$5,000**
- 5,000 to 10,000 customers = **\$10,000**
- More than 10,000 customers = **\$15,000**



DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION GRANT

This competitive \$10,000 grant is available for Power Agency members in NCEMPA and NCMPA1. This grant has no match, but is only available to a member city or town once every three years.

In any calendar year that a member receives the \$10,000 grant, the member community is not eligible for the \$5,000 Smart Communities Grant. The member is eligible for the \$5,000 Smart Communities Grant in years two and three following receipt of the Downtown Revitalization Grant.

Proceeds from the Downtown Revitalization Grant may be used for a wide range of purposes so long as that purpose advances the downtown revitalization goals of the member community and has the approval of the city/town manager.
