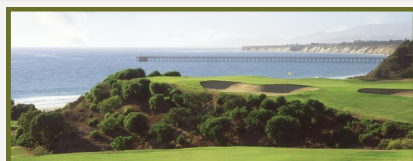

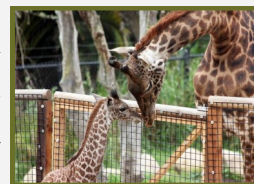

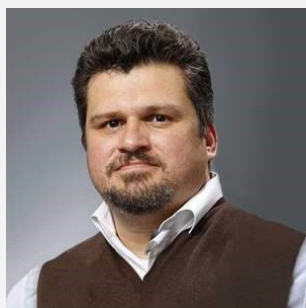

Kennedy School of Government, he is the author of "A Darker Shade of Crimson: Odyssey of a Harvard Chicano" (Bantam). He has written for eight magazines and worked for three newspapers: The Arizona Republic, The Dallas Morning News, and The San Diego Union-Tribune. He is a popular speaker on the national lecture circuit and the President/CEO of Ruben Navarrette Presents..." — a unique series of informative live stage interview-style conversations with Latino newsmakers and thought leaders. He has also served a guest lecturer in journalism and communications at Wheaton College in Illinois. He judged the contest for the Pulitzer Prizes in 2013, 2014, 2016, and 2017. 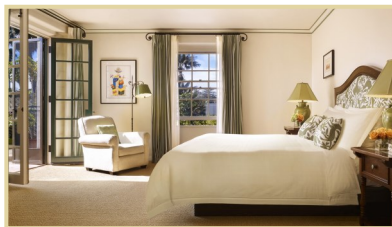
