

## ES-CA Members and Residents of Sundance Mesa

Vulcan Materials has informed me that all mining (extraction) activity at the Placitas mine has concluded, which is considerably ahead of the expected schedule. The processing of already mined material will continue to prepare it for sale to their customers. The stockpile of processed material visible from Camino Manzano will continue to be sold until depleted.

The next phase for Vulcan will be the reclamation of the remaining mined areas. Similar to the reclamation of Area 1, this work will be contracted to an outside company. As of now, no contractor has been named, and a start date has not been set. I will provide an update once this information is available. Three areas are scheduled for reclamation, which will involve heavy equipment and significant earth movement. Residents should anticipate some dust during this process. Vulcan will continue to provide water trucks to keep it to a minimum. Sundance Mesa will specifically be impacted in Area 4 due to the removal of the berm constructed a couple of years ago.

Communication with Vulcan management at the mine remains strong, and I plan to issue periodic updates until all work is completed. It is important to note that Vulcan is not leaving the area; their mining activity will simply transition to the Baca Mine, located on the Frontage Road near the north end.
