Outdoor Recreation & Splash Pads

Many local parks provide free water play areas to cool off during the June heat:

- Harry Crabb Park (Roseville): Features a popular interactive splash pad with a crab theme, plus sand volleyball and playgrounds.
- Johnson-Springview Park (Rocklin): Offers an expansive splash zone alongside trails, a skate park, and disc golf.
- Whitney Community Park (Rocklin): Provides separate play structures for toddlers and older kids right next to a large splash pad.
- Bayside Splash Pad (Roseville): A free water play area and playground open to the public during daytime hours.

Nature & Hiking

- Miner's Ravine Trail (Roseville): A paved walking and biking trail through scenic community greenways, ideal for easy family outings.
- Auburn State Recreation Area: Offers free guided bird walks and extensive hiking trails with canyon views.
- Maidu Regional Park (Roseville): Features paved and natural trails, a playground, and occasional community events.
