Mission of Workgroup:

Provide input and engagement on proposed events, promotions and activities; act as agents circulating information resulting in successfully implementing and achieving the overarching goal of promoting Victor to both internal and external audiences.

Lisa welcomed everyone, asked them to introduce themselves and mentioned since the meeting was at Six50 tonight, manager Gail Brink would open the meeting talking about Six50 and what they can offer along with any changes they are making.

Six50 Black Oven Cooking

- They have three locations, Victor, Chili and a summer place on Sodus Point. The new menus for lunch and dinner will be coming out in a few days. For dinner they have decided to omit the sandwiches and put a few more Entrees on it. Just trying something new. The Victor location has been opened almost three years and she is looking forward to participating in Spooktacular again this fall. They are also participating in Victor's National Night Out event tomorrow night.
- They do have party rooms to utilize. If a party is not booked for them, you can use them. They also rent out the Restaurant for events, which would include food and drinks. The restaurant holds about 180 people.
- They still offer the Birthday special which is you get the same number of wings as your age!! It must be on your actual birthday unless they are closed.

Spooktacular

- The dates are Friday, October 26th for Adult Night and Saturday, October 27th for Kids Trick-n-Treating.
- There was discussion on decorating the poles in front of your business, which will be a contest. We want the community decorated better and Lisa will be sending more information out on that.
- There will be sponsorship opportunities
- We will be extending the time frame for the Friday night event.
- The Village DPW department will purchase Spooktacular banners for the lamp post and they will be put up from end of September until after Spooktacular for more publicity.
- The Plaza where Home Goods is has called Lisa and Grace from Rhino Chiropractic has agreed to assist with getting those stores to participate in the Saturday kids event!
- Lisa is creating a tool kit for this event for the businesses. Her goal is to have the tool kit out by the 1st week in October and the bags will be out by the 2nd week of October.

- We will be doing bag again this year and you will have an opportunity to have your name and the businesses will be able to get them prior to the event.
- Lisa has a meeting with Deviant Desserts to participate in this event for the Adult night. Lisa will keep us informed.
- Lisa mentioned that she is looking for Spooktacular committee members.
- Heidi said they will be decorating their place and she does want to participate in some way. Lisa mentioned she was looking for a place for a mini spook house. Heidi said to contact her because they also have a path in the woods we could perhaps utilize.

- We also will receive all the Small Business Saturday promotional stuff from American Express again, which has great tools and giveaways.
- We hope to have a themed wine walk that same day, perhaps the noon-4pm timeframe.
- We will have some holiday music, dressed up characters and some choirs on the street corners.
- We would like to set the tone differently more engaged to getting customers in your shop to shop.
- We will be doing the balloons again, which were filled with money, perhaps this year we will also add balloons that maybe have coupons in them instead of nothing.
- Lisa would like to set business hours, just to make sure everyone is open.

Miscellaneous Topics

- 2019 the group would like to see the Pizza/Chili walk take place again – perhaps with more time to plan have it kick off the Taste of Victor.
- The Team Leader idea seems to be losing steam, so there will be a separate meeting with them to see if they are still on board or would they like to drop out of it. We need their support to help get material distributed and to help spread the word on event or meetings. We will see where we stand with this after the meeting with them. We recognize they are volunteering and busy with their own businesses but do need some help.
- Fairy Doors, Lisa from Artful Fairy, would like to do another round of Fairy Doors and get some new businesses involved. She is still trying to figure out the logistics of it. Jill asked Lisa to explain the concept of the fairy doors to her again.
- Lisa Hubler wants to mention to the business owner that have fairy doors to dress them up for Spooktacular. Lisa and Lisa will talk about more fairy door ideas for the Saturday Kids Spooktacular.

- Lisa wanted to let everyone that Cork49 one-year anniversary is coming up on August 25th noon-11pm, with complimentary tastings and Gourmet Goodies are involved with desserts for the event. There will also be live music.

Hang around Victor Day

- Jodell from Victor Chamber of Commerce came to talk to the group about her event which is on Saturday, Sept. 8th
- They are having a tiny house at Hang around Victor Day (HAVD) and the businesses are welcomed to put their product, business cards, items in it. The house will be on display.
- They are also offering to either make a raffle basket that can be displayed at their location and then the day of HAVD brought to the Chamber booth for the drawing or if the businesses would rather the chamber can incorporate one large basket with goodies from the businesses. Jodell was looking for input. Jill said for herself, she would want to donate a basket of her own, the others agreed. She said for the large basket she would contribute a gift card. Jodell would like the baskets by Sept. 7th at her office. Lisa asked Jodell to please get the write up to her and she will get it to the Businesses.
- Jodell mentioned to feel free to do whatever you want in front of your place and if you want a space in the actual area it is of no cost to you.
- Jill offered many ideas to get people to your booth and said why not take advantage of a “free booth”
- Advertising is going out soon and Jodell wants to make sure everyone participating is in the map insert, so she must know about the booth by the 10th of August.

Christmas in the Village

- Kathy passed out information that Mike Stockman provided for this event, which is on December 1st. What he is looking for is business participation that day and for you to let him know what you will be doing in your store or if you need to set up one of his activities he provides throughout the day.
- Kathy mentioned if you do use one of his activities it is for only one hour in your store, so you should have other things planned as the crowd does tend to follow the activities.
- Mike Stockman needs to have this information back to him by October 26th.

Before closing Lisa asked how the group felt about the meetings, if they wanted to go to every other month, every month, etc. Most of the group want to meet every month.
