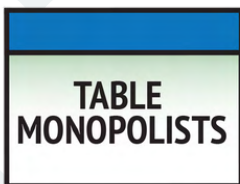

AUCTION 101: BIDDING RULES

SILENT AUCTION

The Silent Auction takes place from 6:00 – 9:00pm.

All items have bid sheets nearby. Persons wanting to bid must do so by writing their auction number on the printed bid sheet.

Bidding increments have been predetermined and bid sheets were prepopulated with bid amounts. You may write in your auction number on any line representing the amount you intend to bid.

No bid sheets are to be removed from the auction table except by an auction committee representative. No bid may be crossed out or erased. Bids properly entered are valid and binding.

The highest bid circled by the auction committee shall constitute the final winner.

All sales are final. No exchanges or refunds are permitted. All items are sold "as is". Gift certificates cannot be replaced if lost or stolen and are not redeemable by cash.

Payment in full for all items must be made on February 22, 2025 via credit card. All effort to indicate any restrictions on items has been made but it is the responsibility of the high bidder to verify all restrictions before bidding.

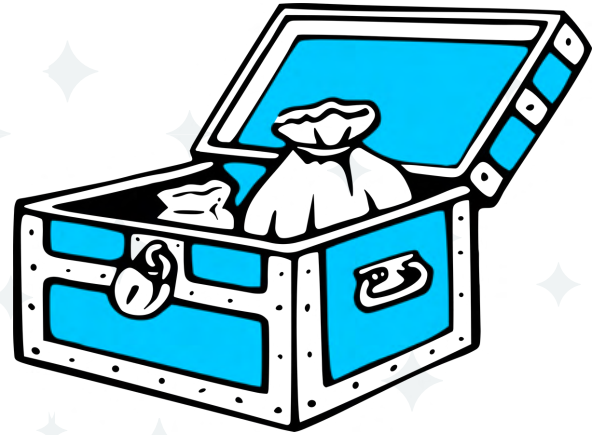
HEROES AUCTION

A Heroes Auction will be included as part of the live auction.

Auctioneer will announce the item and dollar amount associated with the item.

Anyone who wishes to contribute to the announced dollar amount to purchase the item for the school will raise their paddle.

Multiple bidders may raise their paddle at once and must keep their paddle raised until the auctioneer or designated auction volunteer has announced their paddle number and confirmed their purchase.



LIVE AUCTION

Place your live auction bids by raising your auction paddle and be recognized by the Auctioneer.

The Auctioneer has sole discretion to determine bidding increments for each item and shall have the sole and final authority to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer or re-sell at any time.

Acceptance of your bid by the Auctioneer constitutes a binding contract for the purchase of the item.

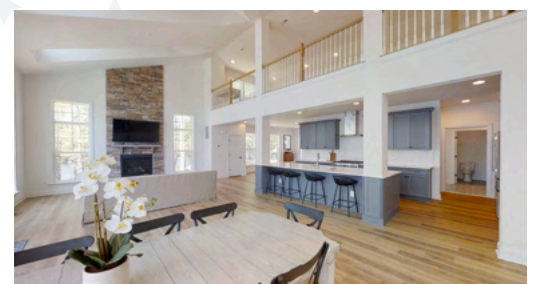

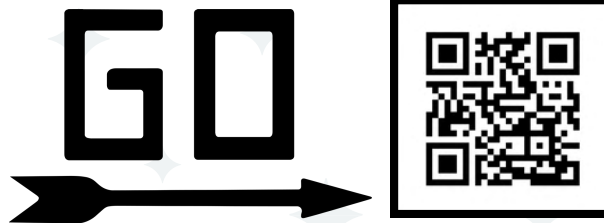
