Key Elements of the Award Program Eligibility

To be considered for the PTO Distinguished Volunteer Service Award, a candidate must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- ✓ Candidates must be a parent/guardian of a current St. Louis School student in good standing.
- ✓ Candidates must have actively served or are currently serving on a PTO committee or other appropriate volunteer position at the school in the last 12 months.

The following are NOT eligible for this award:

- ✓ Current PTO Officers
- ✓ Paid employees of St. Louis School

Nomination Process

- 1. Provide the Nominee's contact information (name and email)
- 2. Include who is making the nomination (name and email)
- 3. Please provide information that helps evaluate the nominee's contribution to the school (such as a brief description of volunteer service to the school)

- 5. Nominations must be completed by **Friday**, **April 13**, **2018**.

*Please note:

- ✓ Volunteers may nominate themselves or be nominated by others.
- ✓ St. Louis school teachers and faculty may be contacted to help gather the necessary quantitative information on any candidate being nominated.

Review Process for the PTO Distinguished Volunteer Service Award

A selection committee comprised of teachers, faculty and PTO Officers will review all submissions to determine eligibility and choose the final candidate based on set criteria.

Announcement of Award Recipient

The winner will be identified by April 20, 2018. The winner will be formally recognized and honored during the general PTO meeting on May 15, 2018.
