How do I pay for what I win?

The Auction has gone mobile this year! Please download and register for the HANDBID app. A couple can register independently with their own bid paddle numbers [separate invoice] or download the app & sign in with the same account [consolidated invoice].



For the Live Auction, bidders will still receive a physical paddle & bidding will not be done through the Handbid app. At the end of the evening, your purchases will be locked in through the Handbid app and all sales are final. Purchases will be reconciled and credit cards charged by 03/05/2020. Purchase receipts will be sent via email automatically through the Handbid system.

Beverage Policy

The St. Louis Catholic School PTO has a banquet license from the Virginia Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control to legally serve beer and wine to our guests who are 21 and older. Please do not bring in any outside alcoholic beverages for consumption or decor that may hinder our ability to obtain a license in the future. Prior to receiving your paddle number, we will ask each attendee to sign a waiver acknowledging that they understand the policy.
