## Here are the details:

- 1. Read 3 books over the summer

- 3. Also include YOUR name, Book Title, Author's name, and copyright date

By all means, read more than 3 books! I only require 3 for the assignment.

Part 2: If you keep track of the hours you read this summer you may include those in your first Reading Log. Keep a sticky note in your book and write down how long you read each time. It adds up. This part 2 is NOT a requirement...but try to do it anyway.

I would like you to use a 4x6 inch index card. These are larger than the 3x5's. If needed, you could cut a 4x6 inch card from stiff paper.

If you have issues with handwriting you are allowed to type your assignment, but, you must cut to fit 4x6 card and glue it down.

This assignment of the 3 cards book summaries will not be due the first day of school. They will be due on Thursday 8/29/19 when you come to class. This will be your first Literature assignment.

Please choose books you are interested in. My only stipulation would be no picture books and books should be approximately 100 pages (give or take). Fiction, non-fiction, biography, autobiography, longer graphic novels, it is up to you. Also, please read something you have not read before.
