Signing below indicates you understand and agree to the following:

1. The assigned device belongs to St. Louis Catholic School
2. Any use of this device must be in full compliance with the Diocesan Acceptable Use Policy which outlines acceptable and responsible use of computer equipment when using this device
3. It is the responsibility of the student to protect the assigned device from damage, loss, or theft
4. Student is responsible for transporting the device, fully charged, and its charger to and from school on a daily basis (**there is only one charger per device**)
5. Changes to the hardware are not permitted (no stickers, etc.)
6. Student will not trade devices with other students
7. The assigned device will be returned in the same condition it was issued (except for normal wear and tear)
8. The student is responsible for alerting their teacher immediately if the assigned device stops working, requires service, or the device gets lost/stolen
9. It is the responsibility of the student to bring the device fully charged to school each day
10. The student will return the device and its charger at the end of the school year
11. The student is responsible for the cost of repairs or replacements if they are determined to be caused by intentional damage or neglect
12. The St. Louis Catholic School technology team has the ability to remotely manage the device and may find it necessary to track, lock, and/or wipe the device for security reasons
13. Student is responsible for returning the device and associated peripherals to the school by the last day of the school year, or immediately upon leaving the school, whichever applies
14. St. Louis School has the right to inspect the contents of any device at any time. The use of the device is a privilege and all users have no expectation of privacy
