You are eligible to apply if you are:

- Passionate about the environment and contributing to environmental conservation.
- A degree-seeking, undergraduate student, from Mohave or Yavapai County, and/or currently enrolled at a college operating in Mohave or Yavapai County.

Deadline:

- Application submission period begins October 1, 2023.
- Deadline for receipt of all materials is **November 15, 2023**.
- All requested information must be emailed to the Prescott Audubon Society at scholarship@prescottaudubon.org. Essays or transcripts submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
- Email subject should read: PAS App - [LAST NAME], [FIRST NAME].
- Only completed applications will be considered.

Application Requirements:

1. Application Form

2. Academic transcript (unofficial accepted).

3. Short essay (500 words or less) Address **ALL** the following points:

- How do you define "environmental conservation?"
- Make a *compelling* argument on how or why your field of study, as you hope to practice it, can contribute to environmental conservation.
- Briefly describe how you plan to use the \$1,000 scholarship funds.

Criteria for Evaluation: Selection will be based on the quality of the essay and the quality of the applicant's academic work.

Notification of award will occur on or around November 22, 2022.

Requirements of Recipient: The award must be used within two years from the date awarded. The awardee agrees to allow Prescott Audubon Society to publicize the scholarship winner's name, photo, biography, and home county on the PAS website and local and/or regional publications.
