# RED CONTROL MEASURES

2nd Wave

Markham Fire and Emergency Services is working with the Executive Leadership Team to provide regular high level weekly updates to Staff, and Council.

CONTROL: Stringent measures: Broader-scale actions and restrictions across multiple sectors to control the spread. Restrictions are the most severe available before widescale business or organizational closings. Always stay home if you have symptoms, physically distance by staying two metres apart from people you don't live with, wear a mask or face covering in indoor public spaces and avoid non-essential travel.


#### **NEW THIS WEEK:**


York Region in collaboration with local municipalities opened "by appointment ONLY" COVID vaccination clinics in Richmond Hill, Newmarket and Georgina. Mass Vaccination Centres bookings currently for persons 80+. Go to york.ca/covid for up to date information.

Announced on March 5 that Stay at Home Order for Peel and Toronto will be lifted March 8th at 12:01am as they go into Grey Lockdown Measures.

Experts are concerned that if daily case rates in Ontario are maintained above 1000 that there is a possibility to enter into a 3rd Wave which will be predominantly cases with Variants of COVID.


Key criteria for York Region enter into Orange Restrict Measures are: Percent positivity is 1.3 to 2.4%, Re is approximately 1 to 1.1 in addition to the Medical Officers of Health from the Region and Province looking at healthcare capacity.
