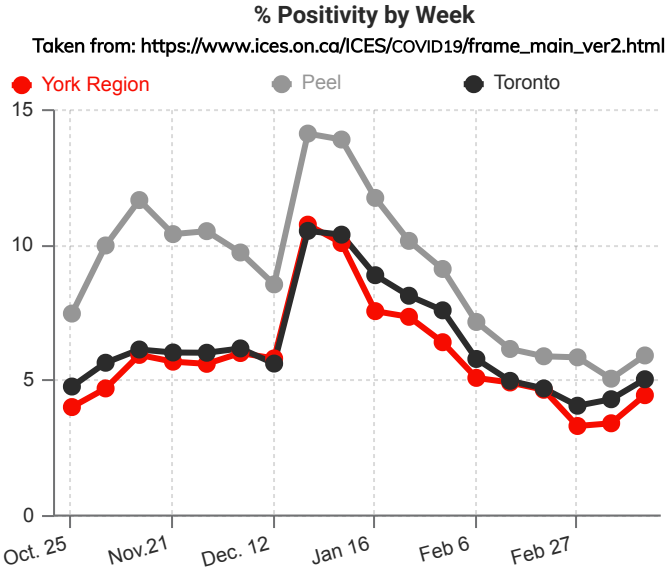
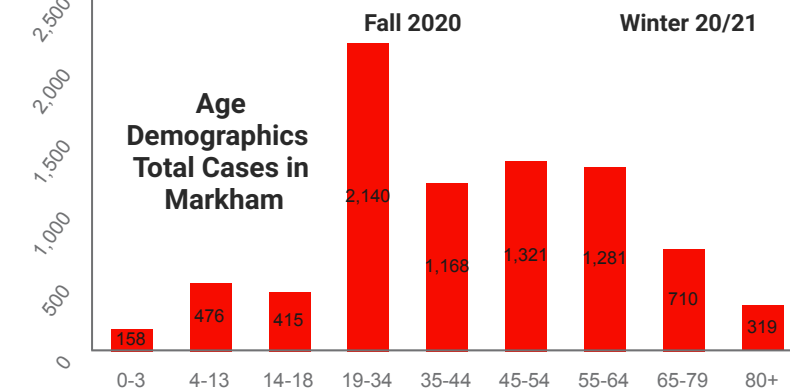
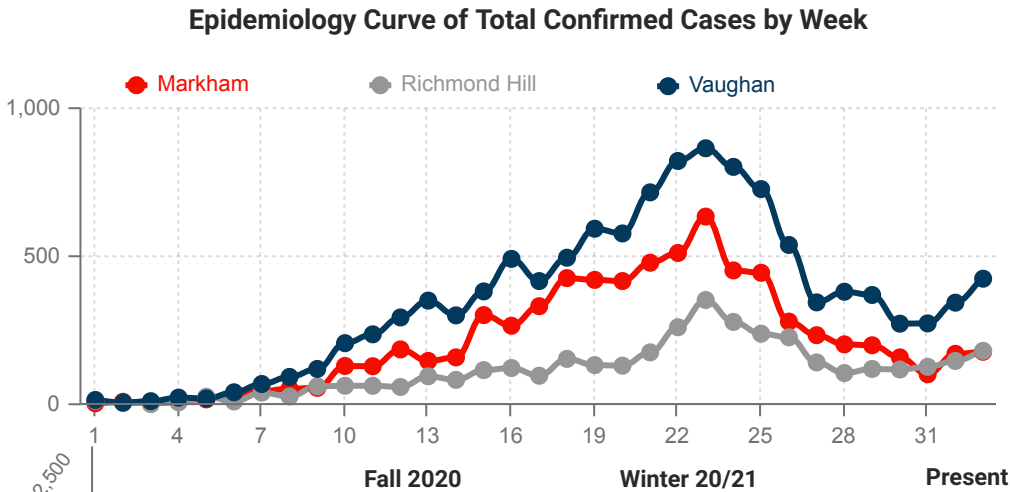
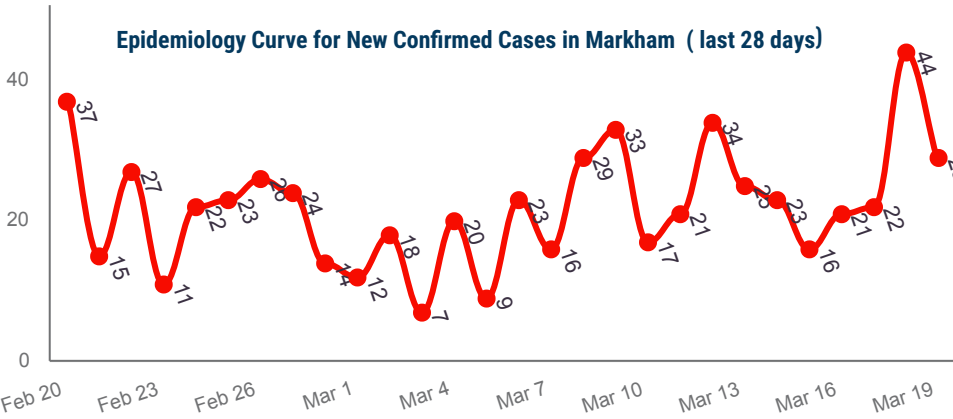
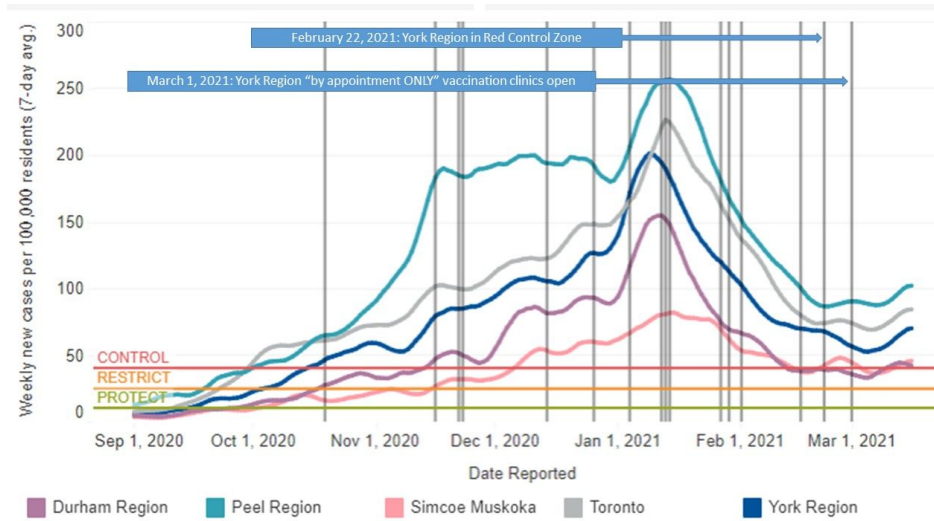
Pandemic

Markham Fire and Emergency Services is working with the Executive Leadership Team to provide regular high level weekly updates to Staff, and Council .

CONTROL: Stringent measures: Broader-scale actions and restrictions across multiple sectors to control the spread. Restrictions are the most severe available before widescale business or organizational closings. Always stay home if you have symptoms, physically distance by staying two metres apart from people you don't live with, wear a mask or face covering in indoor public spaces and avoid non-essential travel.
