RED CONTROL MEASURES

Markham Fire and Emergency Services is working with the Executive Leadership Team to provide regular high level weekly updates to Staff, and Council.

CONTROL: Stringent measures: Broader-scale actions and restrictions across multiple sectors to control the spread. Restrictions are the most severe available before widescale business or organizational closings. Always stay home if you have symptoms, physically distance by staying two metres apart from people you don't live with, wear a mask or face covering in indoor public spaces and avoid non-essential travel.


### **NEW THIS WEEK:**


After independent and thorough scientific reviews for safety, efficacy and quality, Health Canada has approved four vaccines for use in Canada:

- Pfizer-BioNTech approved on December 9, 2020
- Moderna approved on December 23, 2020
- AstraZeneca approved on February 26, 2021
- Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) approved on March 5, 2021

Starting March 10, 2021, select pharmacies in the following public health units are booking appointments for AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccines for eligible people between the ages of 60 and 64 (at the day of vaccination or, if you will be or have been 60 to 64 in 2021):

- You must have an appointment to get vaccinated at a participating pharmacy.
- Must be between the ages of 60 and 64 (as of the day of vaccination or if you will be or have been 60-64 in 2021)
- Have a valid Ontario health (OHIP) card, or other form of valid government-issued identification
- Locations are:
  - Kingston, Frontenac, Lennox and Addington
  - Toronto
  - Windsor-Essex County


