
Crossing Rehabilitation at Highway 7 in Markham

The Local Project

As a part of Metrolinx's Corridor Maintenance program, construction will take place at the railway track crossing at Highway 7 and the Stouffville rail corridor, in Markham to support track infrastructure and corridor maintenance.

What Work Is Taking Place?

From June 10, 2022 to June 13, 2022, contractors will be performing a full railway crossing rehabilitation. They'll be removing and replacing all of the ballast, and installing a new track panel, concrete, and asphalt.

What to Expect

Construction activities will take place during the **overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.** Highway 7 will be **closed at the track crossing** to do a full railway crossing rehabilitation. The railway will not be affected.

Residents may experience noise from the use of construction equipment, but heavy machinery will be outfitted with a white noise back-up alarm to limit the amount of noise.

Every effort will be made to minimize noise and visual impacts as much as possible. We apologize for any inconvenience, and we ask for your patience as we complete this necessary work.
