



SERVICE HOURS INFORMATION

Christian Service asks that we give more of ourselves. It is transformative and involves an encounter with another in order to accompany and stand in solidarity with those who are in need (lacking resources such as food, clothes, shelter, or healthcare). The act of Christian Service takes us out of ourselves and involves sacrifice as we are challenged to demonstrate the love and mercy of God to those who are struggling and suffering. This is different from volunteering, which is of course a helpful and necessary action, but true Christian Service puts us in a position to walk in solidarity with those in the margins.

By April 15, students should log their 15 hours (or more) of completed service in Naviance. No additional paperwork or signatures are required. Naviance provides students access to their service resume easily for scholarship and college applications.

- Click on the appropriate link that corresponds to your grade level in school. This link was also emailed to you by Mrs. Dougherty.
 - There is a separate form for freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors. Please use the correct form.
- For every service opportunity completed, students are asked to share:
 - The name of the organization/opportunity
 - The date or dates of the service opportunity
 - The total number of hours completed at the site
- After entering all of the required information for each service opportunity, students are asked to answer two reflection questions.
- Students are strongly encouraged to select the "Send me an email receipt of my responses" option at the bottom of the form so students may refer back to their responses for future college and scholarship applications
- Students must select the "submit" button when all information is completed
