### Phase 3 of Reopening begins Monday July 6<sup>th</sup>

Fitness & health clubs, gyms, and facilities for yoga, weights, spinning and other classes may reopen with under 40% occupancy, sanitizing after every use, and other standards and guidelines.

Museums & cultural facilities may reopen with recommended timed ticketed entry and small guided tours can resume. Larger tours (e.g. duck boats, whale watches) may reopen with limited capacity of 50%.

- Post-Secondary/Higher Ed/Vocational-Tech/Trade/Occupational Schools — general operations
- Casino gaming floors
- Horse racing simulcast facilities (no spectators)
- Indoor recreation and athletic facilities for general use (not limited to youth programs)
- Fitness centers and health clubs including:
  - cardio/weight rooms/lockers rooms/inside facilities
  - fitness studios (yoga, barre, cross fit, spin classes, general fitness studios)
  - indoor common areas
  - indoor swimming pools
  - indoor racquet courts and gymnasiums

- locker rooms/shower rooms
- excluding saunas, hot tubs, steam rooms
- Museums
- Indoor historic spaces/sites
- Aquariums
- Outdoor theaters and performance venues of moderate capacity
- Indoor theaters, concert halls, and other performance venues of moderate capacity
- Sightseeing and other organized tours (bus tours, duck tours, harbor cruises, whale watching)
- Fishing and hunting tournaments and other amateur or professional derbies
- Weddings/events/gatherings in parks, reservations, and open spaces with allowances for moderate capacity
- Overnight camps
- Indoor non-athletic instructional classes in arts/education/life skills for persons 18 years or older
- Indoor recreational businesses: batting cages, driving ranges, go karts, bowling alleys, arcades, laser tag, roller skating rinks, trampolines, rock climbing.

**Gatherings revised Effective July 6<sup>th</sup> (*July 13 in Boston*)**

Indoor gatherings limited to 8 persons per 1000 sq. ft. but no more than 25 in a single enclosed space.

Outdoor gatherings limited to 25% of facility-permitted occupancy with maximum of 100 people in a single enclosed outdoor space. Event bars and dancefloors must remain closed. Does not apply to unenclosed gatherings (e.g. parks or backyards.) Does not supersede specific guidance in the reopening plan.

**Phase 3 may have additional phases within it and is expected to last much longer than prior phases, continuing to be dependent upon the health data that drives the phases. Details are updated at <https://www.mass.gov/info-details/reopening-massachusetts>**
