# 2025-2026 Advancement Plan & Goals

#### 1. Pay off the existing loan - \$450,000:

The first priority is to eliminate the remaining debt on our Child Enrichment Center (CEC) facility. Our church has already retired over \$600,000 of the original \$1.2 million in construction costs. This was our church's most recent property investment.

#### 2. Establish a capital maintenance fund – \$100,000:

While CEC and PDO operations include maintenance budgets, they are not sufficient to cover major facility needs. This fund will ensure long-term sustainability and readiness for larger maintenance expenses.

#### 3. Plan for a new CEC addition - \$450,000:

Our current CEC serves approximately 50 children and has a waiting list of about 50 more. The PDO currently serves approximately 35 children. Expanding both programs will allow us to meet the growing needs of our community and provide faith-based care for more families.
