JUDGING & AWARDS

All entries will be judged if you choose to. Entries will be judged in each division (excludes government) listed on the entry application.

The criteria for judging these entries are as follows:

Winners in each category shall receive the following:

- First Place-Banner to Display on Float
- Runner Up-Banner

In addition, a "GRAND MARSHAL AWARD" winner will be selected from the first place winners in each division. The winner of the "GRAND MARSHAL AWARD" will receive an additional "Grand Marshal" banner to display on their float.



RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Candy can be handed out along the route; however, you are NOT permitted to toss it into the crowd.
- 2. ONLY the 1st 150 UNITS WILL BE ADMITTED INTO THE PARADE There will be a limit of 2 units per company or individual. YOU MUST SPECIFY IF YOU ARE BRINGING A TRUCK AND TRAILER! WE HAVE TO KNOW THE LENGTH OF THE TRAILER. If you say truck and come with truck and trailer you will be turned away.
- 3. The headlights of all units must be turned OFF during the parade. If the lighting for your unit is wired into the headlight circuit or if your headlights cannot be turned off, the headlights of the unit must be covered.
- 4. All units using portable generators shall have a working fire extinguisher and an ample supply of fuel aboard before entering the staging area. No fueling shall be allowed along the parade route.
- 5. No smoking shall be allowed in or on any unit from the time the unit arrives at the staging area until it reaches the end of the parade route.
- 6. Horn blowing shall be reserved for members of the bands in the parade. Please, no horns or sirens!
- 7. All units MUST be decorated for Christmas except for dignitary units, military units, and bands, which shall be exempt from this rule.
- 8. Each entry MUST be decorated and MUST have Christmas lighting. If your entry does not have decorations or lighting, you will not be allowed to participate in the parade.
- 9. All music or singing must be songs of the theme or the Christmas season.
- 10. No motorcycles, dirt bikes, mini-bikes, ATVs, or lawnmowers are allowed in the parade. You may display these vehicles on floats, but they may not be driven in the parade.
- 11. Only ONE unit per application per entry fee. Additional units that arrive on the day of the parade will be turned away.
- 12. NO LIVE SANTAS ON ANY FLOAT except the Chamber of Commerce Santa float.
- 13. Please refrain from making, processing, or preparing food on the route. Pre-packaged items are ok to hand out.

**If any of the above rules are broken, you may not be allowed to participate in future parades. **
