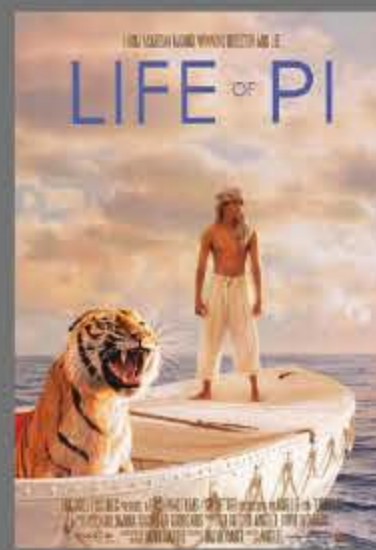


MARCH 8

A compelling tale of how the simple lessons of childhood can heal our adult wounds. Not for children.

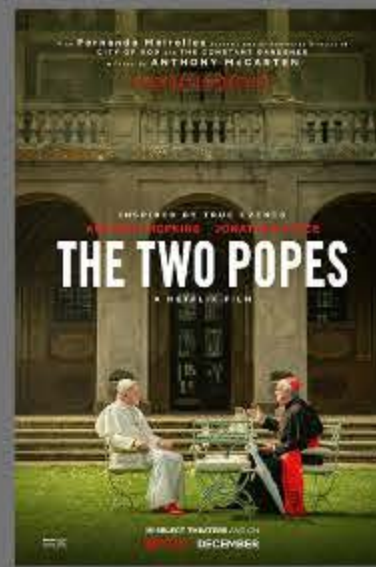


MARCH 15
