Touchpoints is a model for communicating with parents around a child's development but also applicable in a wide range of workplace environments with colleagues, customers and families. We welcome child care professionals, teachers, social workers, mental health specialists, family mentors, and other health and human service agency providers.



The Touchpoints model is an opportunity to engage with parents around important information about their child's development. It emphasizes prevention through anticipatory guidance and development of relationships between parents and providers. The goals of the Touchpoints approach are to:

- optimize child development
- strengthen families
- build communities

Through understanding each Touchpoint and working together to anticipate and recognize them, parents and providers can collaborate on responses that will decrease or prevent other problems.
