



## Grand Canyon Emergency Evacuation Checklist

### Immediate Evacuation: Essential Items



- Medications, dentures, hearing aids and prescription glasses/contact lenses
- Driver's license, passport, and other identification
- Important papers (birth certificates, insurance policies, etc.) if immediately available
- Credit cards, cash, checks
- Personal toiletries and sanitary needs
- Sleeping bags or blankets
- Baby food and diapers
- Pets and pet food, medication, leash or carrier

### Immediate Evacuation: Actions



- Disconnect all appliances except the refrigerator and freezer
- Close doors and windows (not locked)
- Leave exterior porch lights on
- Tie a white or light-colored pillowcase, towel, or similar item to the front door to indicate the residence has been evacuated
- Follow instructions of emergency personnel

### If Time Permits: Items



- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Portable battery-powered radio
- Change of clothing for each person
- Drinking water and non-perishable, ready-to-eat food
- Cell phone and charging cable
- Valuables
- Irreplaceable items and personal mementos

### If Time Permits: Actions



- Secure outdoor possessions and equipment
- Secure or hide valuables
- Turn off propane gas before leaving—know how to do this well in advance
- Register at the designated evacuation collection center (locations will be announced during evacuation)
