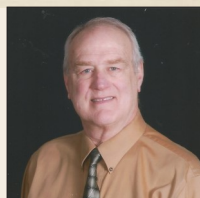

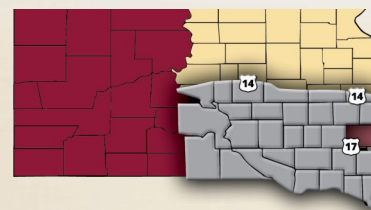

One of the main ministries of CEF® is the *Good News Club*®. The weekly clubs are a place where children are taught a Bible verse, Bible story, missionary story, sing Bible centered songs and interactive games. Most of the Good News Clubs now meet after school in public elementary schools.

The clubs are off to a great start in the Lewis and Clark Area. Right now, there are six Good News Clubs in the Lewis and Clark Area. They are at Bridgewater/Emery public elementary school, Madison public elementary school in Huron, Freeman public elementary school, Jefferson public elementary in Pierre, and Buchanan public elementary in Pierre. You can be in prayer for the new *Good News Club*, which is planned to start in February 2026 at the Marion Public elementary school.

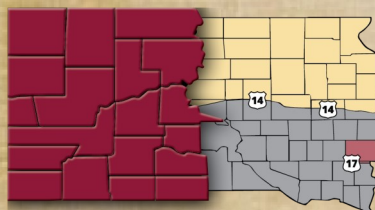

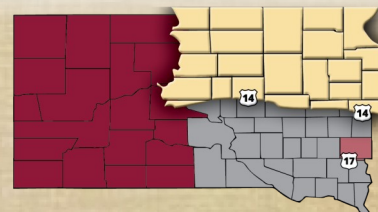
## *New Good News Club Welcomed* By Sakura Eggena

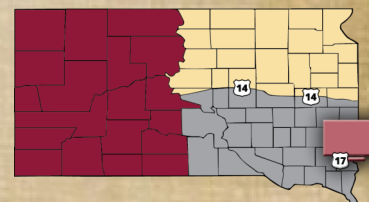
## *Holy Interruptions—Perfectly Timed by God!* By Amanda Barton

Last fall, our Good News Clubs were introduced to Joni Eareckson Tada as the missionary story. The children learned about her life, her faith, and how God uses suffering for His glory. The Beresford Club wrote letters to Joni—and to their amazement, she wrote back..

One leader updated the club this fall, after weeks away due to her husband's medical needs. She distributed Advent cards featuring artwork Joni had painted. Then she quietly slipped out early to get home. But God wasn't finished.

Passing by the after-school program, she felt an unmistakable nudge to go inside. There she met a staff member, a Christian young woman who became a paraplegic as a result of a car accident when she was a teenager. The leader shares,

"I thought, I would just go in and wish her a merry Christmas. When I was there, she said it'd been a very hard week. An 8th grade boy had been run over in a sledding accident, and the whole school was mourning. I shared the Advent cards with her. Then I looked over, and there was a little boy in a wheelchair. I asked if I could give him a card. "Oh, sure," she said. I went over to him and asked him if he would like a picture. He was non verbal but could communicate with his caregiver who understood that, yes, he would like a card. As he was choosing, some girls in the after school program came over to look at the cards too. "Could we have one?" they said. Well, sure. So I gave all of the teacher's cards to the girls, and one of the girls said she used to go to *Good News Club*®." I said, "Well, you should come back. You could all come to *Good News Club*." Fortunately, I had one more Advent Bag in my car that I gave to the teacher. As I left, I thought, "What just happened, God?" I wasn't scheduled to do the missionary story, but God led me to share about Joni that fit with a terrible tragedy that had just happened and connected with these students so I could invite them to *Good News Club*. I drove by amazed at God's timing and his perfect plan.

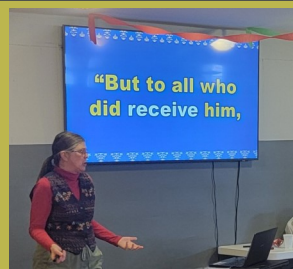
