et us look back on what God has done through the ministry of *CEF*® in the Lewis and Clark Area. The month of June brought another year of teaching at the Christian Youth in Action® (*CYIA*<sup>TM</sup>) training. There were 39 teens who attended the training, which helps to equip teens to minister to children through the 5-Day Clubs.


The summer ministry was packed full of twenty-three 5-Day Clubs held in the Lewis & Clark Area. A total of 310 children attended the clubs and heard the Gospel of Christ, with six children trusting Christ as their personal Savior. The 5-Day Clubs

covered a widespread area of the Lewis and Clark Area. The clubs were held in Huron, Tulare, Howard, Salem, Platte, Parker, Madison, Mt. Vernon, Menno, Mitchell, Marion, Parkston, Madison, Ramona, and Yankton.

There were 557 children who were reached at the Turner County Fair and 154 at the Jamboree Days in Madison.

The month of October brings the start of the Good News Clubs. Right now, we have clubs in Huron, Freeman, and two clubs in Pierre. The clubs in Bridgewater/Emery will start in November.

Just think, over 1,500 children were reached in 2025 with the Gospel in the Lewis and Clark area. Now, the Lewis and Clark chapter is now closing in on our "End of the Year" financial goal. We have \$20,000 left to raise by the end of 2025.
