

As the summer is upon us, we are now focusing on our teens of $CYIA^{\mathsf{TM}}$ and our summer missionary program. This is a very



After our first few weeks I was feeling discouraged, wondering if we were making a difference or if the children were even listening, but God showed us powerfully how He has been working at Lowell. During review week for "Jesus: God Who Saves" we had a fun time with games, prizes, special treats and reviewing the lessons from Passover to the Resurrection. We were astonished at how many key facts the children retained. One of our rambunctious little boys came up to me and said, "I know I John 4:14!
