All St. Hilary's Programs, Events and Worship Services will always follow the most up-to-date guidelines as provided by the CDC to the best of our ability.

Upon arrival on campus, participants will be given a mask if they did not bring one from home, asked to sanitize their hands, provide names and phone numbers of all in their party, sign to acknowledge they have read and agree to these guidelines and will be seated in areas that allow for 6 feet separation from other families.

Please read and Sign your agreement to the following

- If you or a member of your family has had a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher in the past 48hrs, is feeling sick, has a cough, shortness of breath (aside from asthma), or any other symptoms of feeling unwell please do not attend or send your child(ren). Please also remain home if you have knowingly been exposed to anyone with COVID- 19 in the last 14 days.
- We will follow sanitizing and social distancing guidelines at all times, the use of hand sanitizer and social distancing will be enforced by the Adult Volunteers throughout the gathering time.
- 4 All indoor gatherings will take place either in Browning Hall, the Parish Hall or in the Church Sanctuary, where social distancing is possible, and you are asked to stay in the designated areas.
- Masks will be required for all indoor gatherings and are highly encouraged for outdoor gatherings.
- If food or snacks are served, they will be consumed socially distant, and must be brought from home or individually prepared and placed on family/youth tables. Meals may not be shared with those that are not directly related to a family or living companion.
- In the event that you or a member of your family is diagnosed with or show symptoms of COVID-19 with-in 7 days of attending an in-person event we kindly request that you notify the parish administrator immediately so that others that attended the same event may be contacted. Names will be kept confidential, but it is imperative that we make others aware for their own health and safety.
- For youth group gatherings, parents may attend but are not required to. Youth dropped-off will asked to sign this agreement on their own behalf. If a youth is unable to follow these guidelines, the parent will be asked to pick up the youth immediately.
- ♣ Sanitizing spray and wipes will be provided, and we ask that before you leave, you use them to clean all surfaces, chair backs and materials you or your family may have touched. We also ask that you join in the after-event clean-up of all common handles, switches and equipment in the building and bathrooms. Then mark the Clean-up check list for all areas you cleaned for us with our greatest appreciation.
