- 1 WHEREAS, The Southern New England Ministry Network adopted new bylaws on
2 August 5, 2020, and,
3
- 4 WHEREAS, After implementing the new bylaws, it has become evident that certain
5 provisions require clarification, adjustment, or revision to ensure the efficient
6 and effective operation of the organization, and,
7
- 8 WHEREAS, The Executive Presbytery has identified specific areas where modifications
9 will better support the organization's mission, structure, and procedural
10 integrity; and,
11
- 12 WHEREAS, **Article X, Section G. Corporate Treasurer**, currently states:
13
14 *The Corporate Treasurer for the Network will be appointed by the*
15 *Executive Presbytery following the conclusion of each Annual*
16 *Network Conference from among its members. Each term will last*
17 *one year with no limits on successive terms served.*, and,
18
- 19 WHEREAS, The role of the corporate treasurer is very specific, requiring a specific
20 skillset, and,
21
- 22 WHEREAS, That skillset may not be found in any of the Executive Presbyters, and,
23
- 24 WHEREAS, For the financial stability of the Network, continuity is needed for the
25 individual serving in that role; let it therefore be
26
- 27 RESOLVED, That **Article X, Section G. Corporate Treasurer**, be amended as follows:

29 **Article X, Section G. Corporate Treasurer**
30 The Corporate Treasurer for the Network will be appointed by the
31 Executive Presbytery, *following the conclusion of each Annual Network*
32 *Conference from among its members. Each term will last one year with no*
33 *limits on successive terms served.*
