2 August 5, 2020, the resolution included the Southern New England Ministry

14 *and network ministry leaders of the Assemblies of God in MA, RI, and*

17 WHEREAS, The practical work of our network is to identify, develop, resource, and
18 network Spirit-led ministry leaders in MA, RI, and CT, and,

20 WHEREAS, It makes sense to correct the discrepancy for clarity and continuity; let it
21 therefore be

23 RESOLVED, That **Article VI. Purpose for Fellowship** in the current bylaws of the
24 Southern New England Ministry Network be amended as follows:

27 The Southern New England Ministry Network exists to identify, **develop,**
28 resource and network **Spirit-led** ministry leaders of the Assemblies of God
29 in MA, RI, and CT.
